Bill will demonstrate MOARS, an open-source audience response system that can be used for multiple-choice tests and surveys. Free to download and install, MOARS includes <u>a peer</u> assessment module

that can be used to gather rating data for Facets analysis (it provides you with a data file formatted for instant analysis, plus a rudimentary specification file). Although it's called a Peer Assessment system, it can handle any situation where raters use a rubric to assess student performances. Advice and directions for installation of MOARS on a laptop or a remote server will be included.
